



TRAVEL PROGRAM Employment Support (SLES)

Do you need help learning how to travel on public transport?

At Your Enabled Services we understand leaving school and entering adulthood can be a big step. If a participant is in year 12 or of school leaver age and eligible for the NDIS, then we can help develop skills to build confidence and independence.

Our **Travel Program** will deliver and develop the skills that a participant needs to confidently access and use public transport safely and independently.

The Travel program delivers skills to help the participant navigate the public transport network by introducing the use of the TransLink Journey Travel App, or and, how to read and interpret timetables, as well as strategies for dealing with emergencies and safety whilst traveling. Our travel coaches will discuss your transport needs, help plan the journeys and accompany the participant on practice trips.

This program is about laying the foundations for a person to confidently engage with accessing public transport, building their capacity to live an independent life.

What to Expect

12 week program approximately 8 - 10 excursions included in costings.

Classes will be capped at 8 participants, with one trainer and one coach, but when in the community more supports will be on hand. Alternatively, individual sessions can be tailored to your learning style, using your strengths to build capacity, skills, and knowledge to support your growth. Timeframes for completion of this program can be tailored to the participants individual needs.

We'll regularly update your support on your progress, providing them with the tools to assist you to maximise your chance of success.

Participants will be provided with a program guide and will get real life opportunities to solidify the learning content on excursions and with interactive aids.

COSTS and NDIS Funding

Who is eligible for SLES?

SLES is available to NDIS participants who are about to leave, or have recently left, school and would like some extra assistance making the transition to working life. While the supports are typically aimed at year 12 students, anyone who's legally old enough to leave school can access them. This is usually around year 10, but this varies depending on which state or territory you're living in. In most cases, the cut-off age for SLES eligibility is 22.
